

Freshman Applicant Profile Sought by University of Connecticut's School of Engineering

Freshman Applicants to UConn must:

- Be a graduate of an approved secondary school.
- Have completed *at least 16 units* of work (of which **15 units** *must be* college preparatory in nature)
- Be in the upper range of their high school class
- Have achieved an appropriate score on the SAT or the ACT

Applications for Freshman Admissions must include:

- Official high school transcript *or* official GED
- Official SAT *or* ACT scores
- Personal Essay
- Application Fee (Non-refundable)

Minimum High School Course Requirements:

- 4 years of English
- 3.5 years of Math (Algebra I, Algebra II & Geometry required; Pre-Calculus preferred)
- 2.5 years of Social Studies (including at least one year of U.S. History)
- 2 years of a single foreign language (3 years strongly recommended)
- 2 years of laboratory sciences
- 2.5 years of electives
- High School Chemistry
- High School Physics
